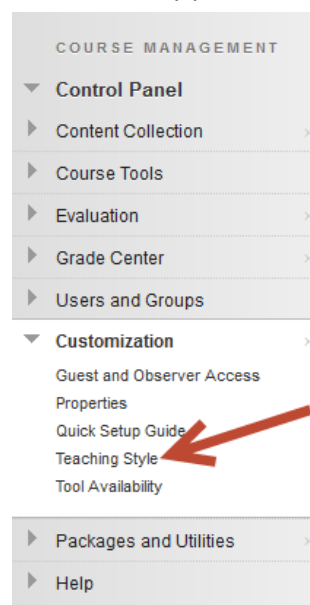


CHANGING THE COURSE ENTRY POINT


The course entry point is the first area users see upon entering your course. The default course entry point is the Home Page and contains modules that alert students to activity in your course. You can change the entry point by choosing an available area from the drop-down list. Available entry points are all the areas appearing on the course menu.

Changing the entry point takes effect immediately for users who log in to the system after the change. Users who are in the system when the change takes place will see the new entry point the next time they log in.

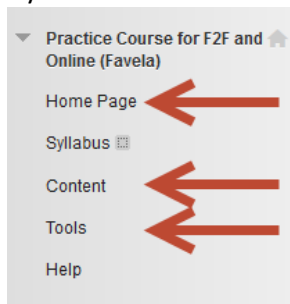
Step 1: In the **Control Panel**, select **Customization**, and then select **Teaching Style**.



Step 2: Under **Select Course Entry Point**, open the drop down box and select the location you would like students to enter the course at.
